<u>Committee Responsibilities</u>: creating the invitation, setting up the stakes, picking up the prizes & delivering them, taking photographs of the pumpkins, tracking the votes, removing the stakes, and discarding pumpkins that are left

Chili Progressive Dinner (Winter) We were only able to hold this event once before covid hit. We had three homes host: appetizers, main meal and dessert. Two of the members made the chili, one made the cornbread. Participants brought an appetizer or dessert and wine to share.

<u>Committee Responsibilities:</u> creating the invitation, planning the menu, picking up the food & supplies, recruiting participants to host and prepare chili-combread.

White Rose Social (Anytime) This is a favorite event of the community. A neighbor offers up their home to host the event. The committee will supply wine glasses and paper goods if host requests. Participants bring an appetizer or dessert and a bottle to share. The host choses the date and time.

<u>Committee Responsibilities:</u> creating the invitation, bringing supplies to the host house

Holiday Party at the Country Club of York (First Saturday of December 6-10pm) Our end of year celebration is held at the Country Club for the adults. We have a set menu, cash bar and door & table prize.

<u>Committee Responsibilities:</u> creating the invitation, planning the menu, purchasing & creating the table decorations, and purchasing the door prize
